Along the way, we hope that you will take note of the unique ways in which we hope to further inspire students within your own community to dream big and to realize their greatest potential.

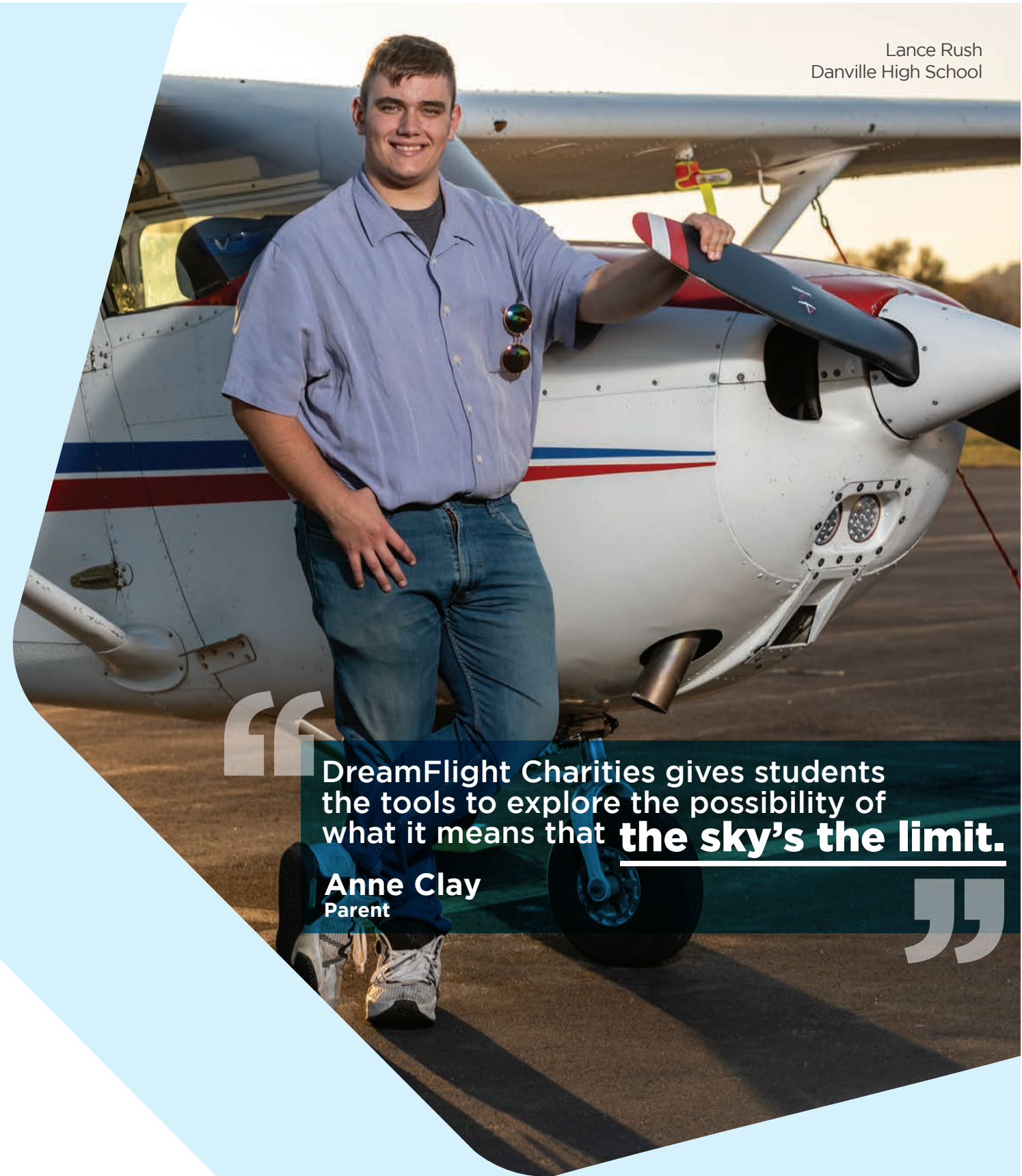

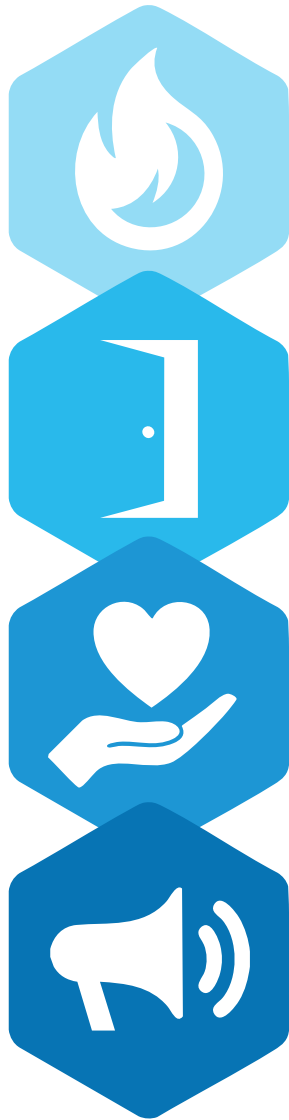

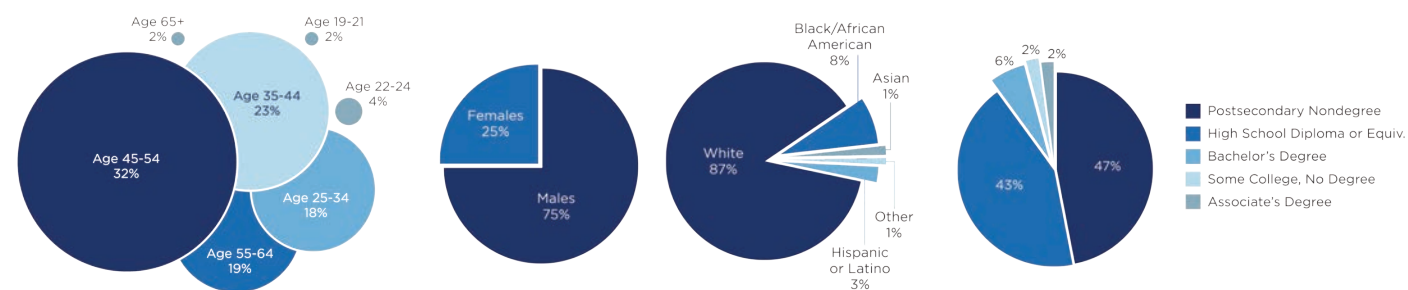
STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES & LOCAL AIRPORTS

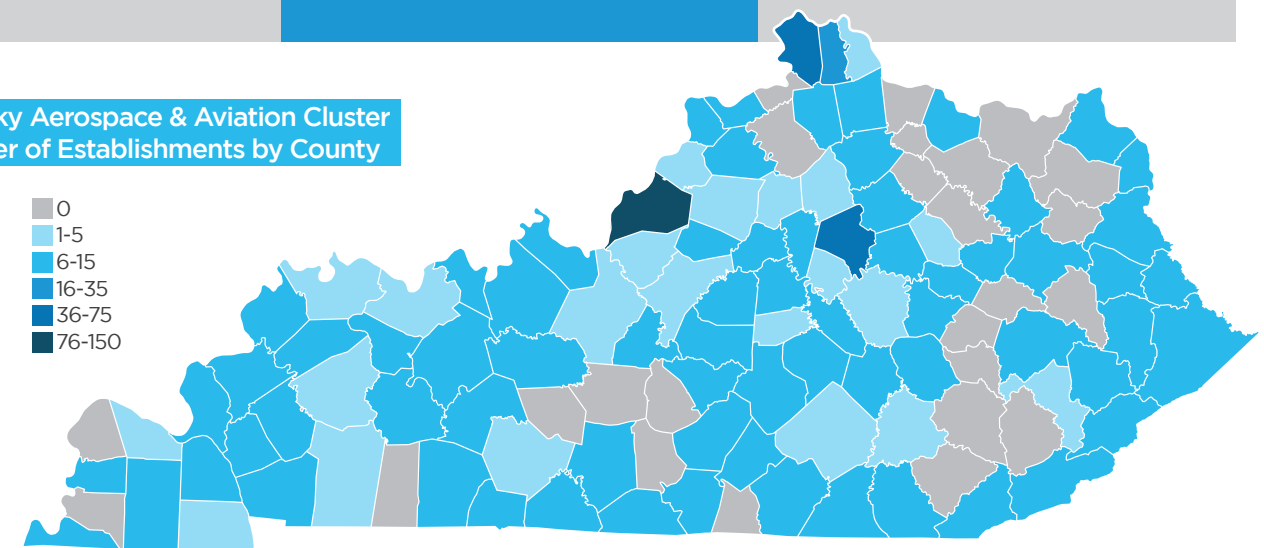
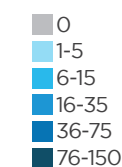

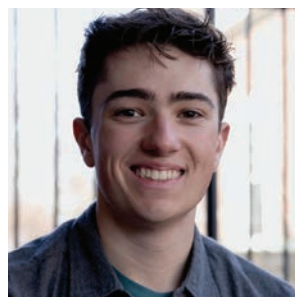

From flight training scholarships to mobile aviation camp experiences that cater to even the most remote parts of our state, our aim is to present the wealth of opportunity that our industry has to offer.

“I will never forget the day that I first took the controls and got to fly the airplane. I was hooked. This has allowed me to get to my solo and discover my passion in life,” says Jackson Erwin, recipient of one of DreamFlight’s many flight training scholarships.

The financial cost of pursuing a career in aviation can be daunting. Thanks to our partners and their generosity, our organization has been able to aid students in taking their first steps to realizing their ambitious future as they take to the skies.

Since beginning his flight training, Jackson has gone on to receive his Private Pilot Certificate and is currently studying at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Florida.

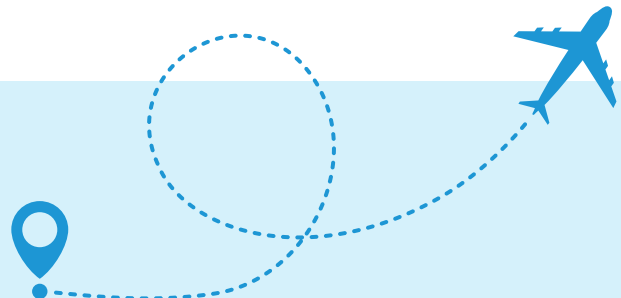
PROMOTING DIVERSITY

While the Commonwealth hosts a robust aviation industry, a quick glance reveals not only an aging workforce, but one that lacks diversity. While reasons for this may vary, DreamFlight Charities has also focused on introducing the wonders of flight to student populations lacking representation in our local aviation community.

“I am a step closer to my future, to my dream,” shares Evie Sapp, another of our scholarship recipients. “I have been involved with aviation not only with my training but in joining additional clubs. I have had the honor of meeting other women in aviation, seeing all of the accomplishments that women have been able to achieve over the years, encouraging my mentality of what women in aviation can do.”

As we look toward the future, our hope is to further shape Kentucky’s aviation community and industry, having it reflect the many unique and wonderful personalities that make up our state’s population.

Through an extended scholarship from DreamFlight and additional funding from the Kentucky Bluegrass 99’s (a female pilot organization), Evie has since received her Private Pilot Certificate and now studies airport management at Eastern Kentucky University.



Evie’s story is just an example of ways we hope to work alongside like-minded organizations, pooling resources and creativity to help the next generation realize their greatest potential.

Discovery Events

DFC Discovery Events provide participants with a unique perspective of the world, all while gauging a student's comfort level, teachability, and margins of success for those interested in applying for one of our flight training scholarships.



Training Scholarships

Our flight training scholarships award up to \$6,000 in flight training, taking a student from zero hours and experience to nearly the time requirement to complete their solo flight in an aircraft.



Aviation Camps

DreamFlight's AVCamp program utilizes mobile flight simulators to bring scalable aviation camp experiences to even the most remote parts of the state while also highlighting your local general aviation airport.



STEM Support

We aim to provide a unique system of support for aviation education throughout or state, from the development of classroom resources to raising funding for both new and existing programs.



Advocacy

11:00 AM Ground School

Our team of Certificated Flight and Ground Instructors (CFIs/AGIs) will lead students through an hour of ground school instruction, teaching the basics of flight and covering concepts that will appear on the Private Pilot Written Exam.

12:00 PM Lunch

We aim to provide an extensive and engaging experience for our participants, providing a hearty meal on-location to help students push forward through the many activities ahead!

12:30 AM Club Meeting

Students will be engaged through a variety of meeting components, including our GUMPS Check (promoting valuable life-skills) and presentations from engaging professionals within Kentucky's aviation industry and community.

1:30 PM STEM Rotations

Open Skies Flight Club caps off the days' activities with a variety of STEM activities, from flight simulation and discovery flights to drone operations and rocketry.

Additional Activities

Student Leadership Meetings

The student leadership team for Open Skies Flight Club meets monthly to plan future club activities while also looking to further membership, development, and community engagement.

Flight Sim Saturdays

We're not restricting the experience to a single event each month! Our flight simulators will be available for reservation on select weekends, providing additional opportunities for students to practice their skills in a safe environment while also learning to navigate a variety of landing challenges!

Annual Discovery Flight

Club membership dues include an annual discovery flight experience with one of our Certified Flight Instructors (CFIs). Students will be engaged on a multiple-destination flight, with their own time at the controls for a brief flight lesson. Discovery flights also serve as a prerequisite in applying for one of DreamFlight's Training Scholarships that award up to \$6,000 in flight training, an amount that will take a student from zero/no experience to nearly their hours required for solo flight in an aircraft!

Club Excursions

Open Skies Flight Club also looks to facilitate a variety of excursions to other facilities, from the Aviation Museum of Kentucky to the control tower of Blue Grass Airport. Regardless of the destination, students will have the opportunity to see the very best of our aviation community firsthand.

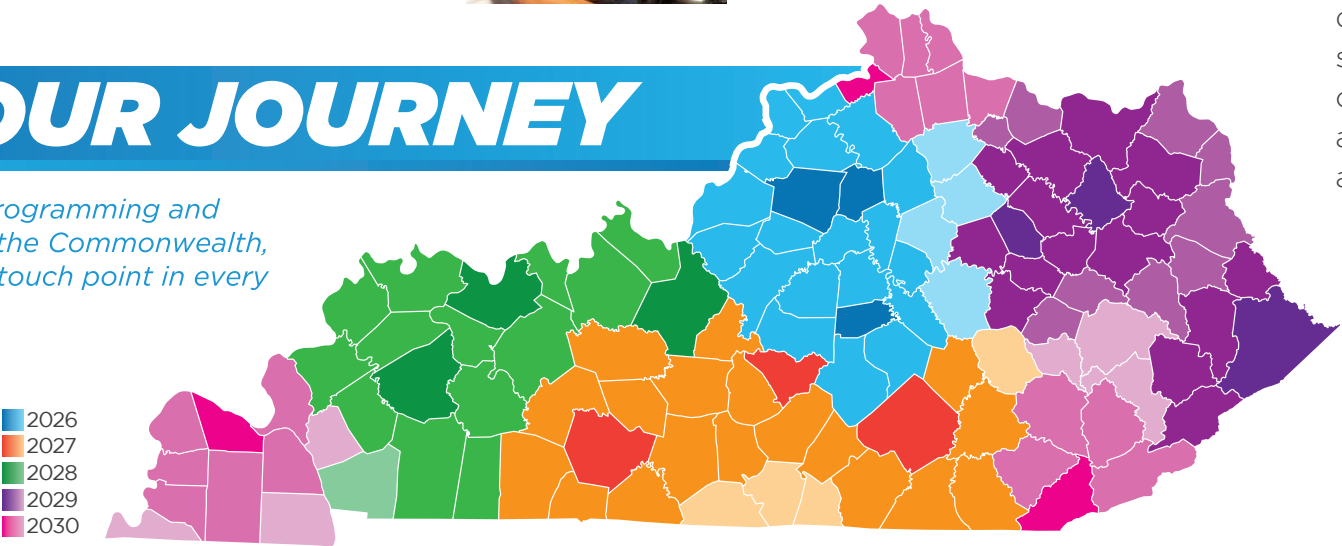

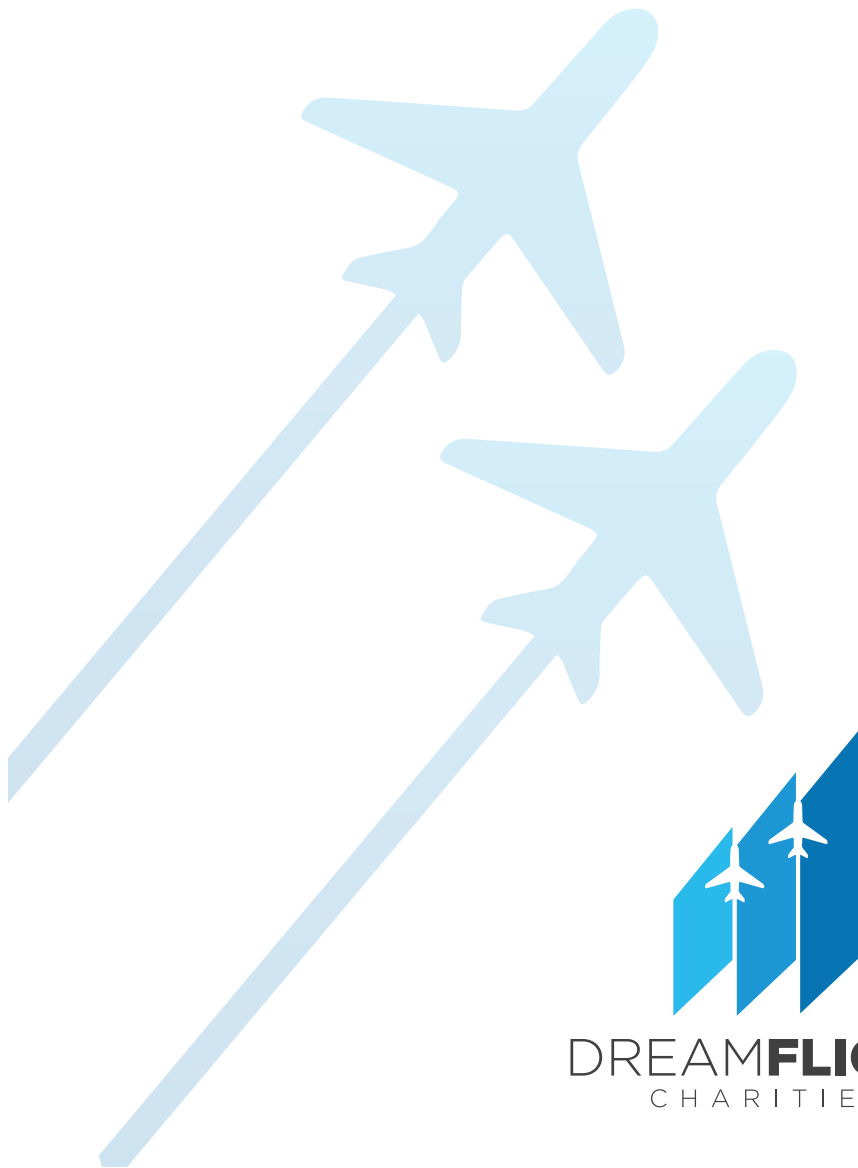
